FROM THE NAVIGATOR

This morning finds QUEEN ELIZABETH crossing Emerald Bank and Sable Island Bank. Early on this morning, at 4.00am, we shall pass 80nm abeam of Halifax on our port side. We shall alter to a more east northeasterly course once we reach Middle Bank, and then pass between Banquereau and Misaine Bank, passing Cape Breton Island on our port side 75nm away. Our passage then takes us across Artimon bank. Tonight, we shall be entering the Laurentian Channel, marking our entrance into the Grand Banks of Newfoundland, before crossing Saint Pierre Bank, then Green Bank.

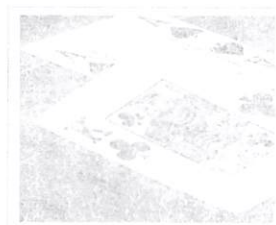

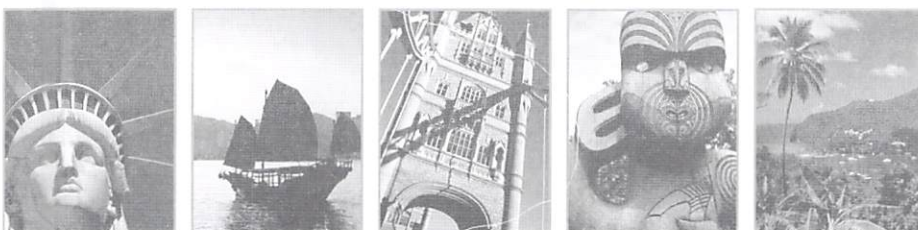

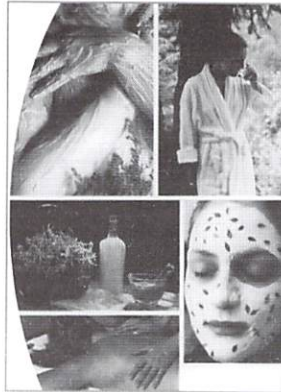

IMPORTANT NOTICE: HEALTH ADVICE

As you will have seen from recent media coverage there are elevated numbers of reported cases of gastrointestinal illness both in the United Kingdom and in the United States. As a precaution we have increased our sanitation measures throughout the ship and this includes procedures that may be visible to you, in particular within the self service restaurants and food outlets. Should you experience any symptoms of vomiting or diarrhoea, please report this by telephone immediately to the Medical Centre from your stateroom by dialling 999/911. We ask for your cooperation to prevent further cases of this illness and recommend that when practical you use the bathroom in your stateroom. It is vitally important that everyone on board maintains excellent standards of personal hygiene as the virus is easily passed on from person to person by touching surfaces such as handrails, door handles and elevator buttons. The single most effective means of prevention is frequent and thorough hand-washing. We recommend that you wash your hands using soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds then rinse and dry them well each time you use the toilet/restroom, after coughing or sneezing and before eating, drinking or smoking. Please try to avoid touching your mouth with your hands. Whilst alcohol hand sanitizers are no substitute for hand-washing, these have been provided for your use in certain food service areas around the ship.
