Today **QUEEN ELIZABETH** shall pass the Avalon Peninsula of Newfoundland, passing Saint Johns 65nm out to port around 4.00am this morning. We expect to experience the effects of the Labrador Current, which flows in a southeasterly direction, descending from Canada. Our course today will see us passing in close proximity to Sackville Spur, then across the Flemish Pass, passing Flemish Cap on our starboard side.
