## AT SEA EN ROUTE TO SOUTHAMPTON, UK



### FROM THE NAVIGATOR

Our east north easterly track sees **QUEEN ELIZABETH** today crossing over the Porcupine Abyssal Plain. The Porcupine Abyssal Plain (PAP), located in international waters, is adjacent to the Irish continental margin. It is a muddy seabed, with scattered abyssal hills that covers an area approximately half the size of Europe's landmass. Its depth measures 4,000 metres (13,000 ft) to 4,850 m (15,910 ft). Later in this evening, we shall enter into the Celtic Sea. We keep the Great Sole Bank on our port side, this bank being positioned southwest of Cornwall.

### NAUTICAL TERM OF THE DAY

**FO'CSLE**  
Forecastle refers to the upper deck of a sailing ship forward of the foremast, but as with all nautical terms of old sailors with strong accents and varying language skills corrupted the word which is now known as the fo'csle. The term "forecastle" relates to medieval shipbuilding, where ships of war were usually equipped with a tall, multi-deck castle-like structure in the bows of the ship which served as a platform for archers to shoot down on enemy ships and could also be used as a defensive stronghold if the ship were boarded. A similar but usually much larger structure, called the aftcastle, was at the after end of the ship, often stretching all the way from the main mast to the stern.
